**Boxtree Lane/ The Avenue/ Chestnut Drive** We got some pot holes fixed in these roads,  but we know there are plenty more. Let us know if your road needs fixing.

**Kenton Lane**  An application to build a block of eight flats was rejected at Planning Committee, following objections by us and local residents

**Weighton Road Flooding**  A number of houses had been affected by flooding during heavy rainfall. We ensured that drain repairs were made by Thames Water.

**Elms Road/Stamford Close**  The kerb stones at this corner had been broken by lorries driving on them. We got the Council to repair them.

**All Saints Church**  There had been a number of fly tips on the track to the woods behind the church. We spoke to the council and got them to jointly fund a gate to stop the tippers getting in.

## Snow and Grit Bins

### Advanced Warning of Road Works

Veolia are replacing lots of the water mains in Harrow Weald over the next year. They will be starting along the **Uxbridge Road** near **Fontwell Close, Brookshill** and the graveyard. During the year they will move down **Boxtree Road, Boxtree Lane** and a number of other roads. The plan runs into 2012.

They will be digging long trenches and they will take a long time, we expect a lot of disruption. They have permission for a fixed time for each hole but some are expected to take up to 4 months. We have a list of how long each hole is allowed to take.
