

Weald 20mph Zone

The Labour council is introducing a 20mph zone around Weald School, including road humps and new yellow lines. We pushed the council to properly consult and listen to residents. We had the consultation delayed as it was planned for the summer holidays.

Many residents objected to road humps in Chestnut Drive and Weald Rise as there is no speeding problem there. The council ignored these wishes, but we were able to get the number of humps reduced. An unpopular one-way system was also dropped. Residents in The Avenue wanted road humps in their road and these were added to the scheme.

We are also pressing for stronger parking enforcement around the school to help local residents.
