Kenton Lane The drains opposite Richmond Gardens were blocked. When it rained the water got very deep at this dip in the road. We got the council to unblock it. 

140 Uxbridge Road We have regularly complained about planning violations here. We will keep on complaining until the issues are fixed. 

Brookshill the drains here were overflowing in heavy rain. We got the council to inspect and they found the problem was in Thames Water's drain. We will keep onto it until it is cleared. 

College Road Bin collectors were refusing to empty a large communal bin from a block of flats. We intervened and collections have now been resumed. 

Kenton Lane The pavement was being overgrown near the entrance to Dromey Gardens. We got the trees cut back to clear the pavement. We would have preferred them cut more, we will keep an eye to check they do not get too big again. 

All Saints Church

The Church and other local groups are planning to open a forest school at a nature reserve off Uxbridge Road.

We helped with their successful funding application to a charity and are now involved in the steering group to help set up the new centre.
