Twickenham Gardens The electrical substation here was broken open and dangerous. UK Power had done nothing. We got the council to complain and it was fixed. 

Elms Road The council took out the bin in the graveyard. We fought for ages and got it put back. However it was not emptied, they have now promised it will be emptied regularly. 

Stamford Close/Elms Road The kerb stones at this corner are often displaced. We got the council to repair them. We also told them we suspect it is the refuse trucks causing the problem by driving on them. 

Weald Rise/Chestnut Drive Vandals pulled down a couple of the school signs. We got the broken ones removed and new ones installed. 

Overgrown Tree on Hutton Lane

The roots were damaging nearby houses. The council had promised to trim it back some time ago but done nothing. When we complained the tree department would not cut it as the tree was owned by the housing department. We eventually got them to see sense and they have promised to cut it back.
