



ENFORCEMENT NOTICE ISSUED TO BARNET FC AT THE HIVE

The Canons Conservative Action Team of Bob Blackman MP including Cllr Amir Moshenson with local candidates Ameet Jogia and Bharat Thakker campaigned against the traffic, noise and nuisance at the Hive following residents complaints. Harrow's Labour administration allowed Barnet FC to play their first team football matches at the Hive. Worse still, there have been the huge floodlights that were installed without planning permission. The West Stand is double the height it should be.

Harrow Conservatives successfully campaigned for refusal of planning permission and enforcement action. Barnet FC appealed so a planning inspector will decide if these structures should remain. The public inquiry begins on 10th June 2014. Barnet FC then brought in London Broncos to play their home Rugby League games at the Hive despite the contract between Barnet FC and Harrow Council not allowing such activity. Now traffic and parking conditions are even worse and will be an all year round problem.

High Priority Given to Planning Enforcement

Planning enforcement has been given a high priority by the new Conservative council, under cabinet member Stephen Greek. Extra resources have been given to the enforcement team, increasing the number of officers from 2 to 5, to deal with the huge backlog of cases left by Labour. Over 300 potential 'beds in sheds' were found using heat mapping technology and are now being investigated. An enforcement notice has also been issued to tackle problems at The Hive in Edgware - this has now gone to appeal and residents will be able to give their views at the planning inquiry later this year.

Good news on extra school places at Harrow East schools

Bob Blackman MP has welcomed the £70 million being provided by the Conservative led Government to provide more than 3,000 additional school places across Harrow. This is in stark contrast to the failure of the last Labour Government to provide these much needed places.

Harrow Conservatives have lobbied hard to obtain this funding. 2 years ago, Harrow's Labour Administration failed to even submit a bid for funding so no money was allocated to Harrow!

Ameet Jogia welcomed the news, "This is great news for local parents who want a place at Aylward Primary school. There is nothing more important than providing the best start in life for our children."

Expanding Avanti Free School

Conservative lead Harrow Council has supported a feasibility study into the use of Whitchurch playing fields in Stanmore, as site for the expansion of Avanti free school - the only school of its kind in the whole of the UK.
