The council is currently being run by a group of councillors known as 'Independent' Labour. This follows a split in the ruling Labour party in Harrow.

This happened after Labour had passed its budget in March, raising council tax by 2%, rejecting Government money for a freeze.

They do not have a majority, so there are now more opportunities for other parties to hold the council to account.

For example, we can now ask more questions at cabinet meetings and see more council papers. At a recent meeting we saved taxpayers over £100,000 by pointing out errors in a council report.

We will continue to stand up for Harrow Weald residents and oppose the council when they go wrong

We had the overgrown island replanted. Contractors then ruined it. We are pursuing them to get it restored to good condition again.

Kenton Lane 
Gardeners from a local housing block had been moving grass and litter on to the street. We reported this to the housing association and it was stopped.
