Successful campaign to keep park gates locked at night at **Harrow Weald Rec, Cedars Park** and **Harrow Weald Cemetery**



Constantly pushing for road and pavement repairs across Harrow Weald. Recent works include **Park Crescent, Richmond Gardens, Long Elmes, College Road** and **Hampden Road**.



New facilities at **Cedars** with a £4 million government investment, regeneration of the derelict **Boxtree Pub** site, a new forest school at **All Saints Church** and rebuilding planned for **Weald and Cedars Manor schools**



New street lights on **Mephram Crescent** and lighting improvements on **Kynaston Wood, Weighton Road** and **Maricas Avenue**



Flowers planted every year along the **High Road** in partnership with the tennis club and local shops, and a new bus shelter at the junction with **Long Elmes**



A new nature trail at **Harrow Weald Common** with improvements to drainage and pathways, and action on traffic safety at **Old Redding**



Standing up for local residents on planning issues at **Kenton Lane, Alma Row, Park Drive, Acacia Close, Kynaston Wood** and **West Drive Gardens**



New inset parking bays on **Stafford Road** and we are fighting for funding to extend the scheme



Council tax freeze from the new Conservative council. Extra street cleaning, grass cutting and hedge trimming, with particular improvements at **Elms Road, Uxbridge Road** and **Boxtree Lane**.



Backing residents on the Weald 20mph Zone consultation in **The Avenue, Chestnut Drive, Weald Rise, Wynchgate** and **Whitegate Gardens**. The council is also buying more CCTV cars to improve traffic enforcement.

We are working **all year, every year** to improve the lives of local residents and to make Harrow Weald cleaner, safer and fairer. Vote Conservative to help us continue this.




