Strong focus on planning enforcement and tackling 'beds in sheds'



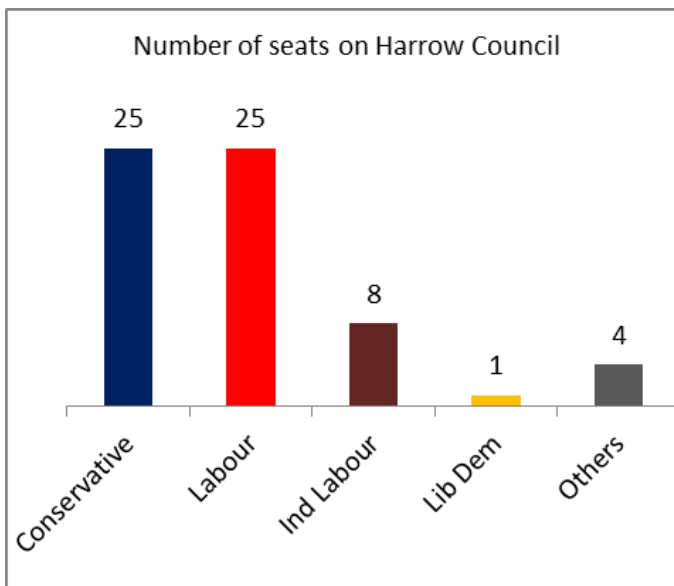
20 minutes free parking being introduced on Harrow's high streets

We need your help to continue the good work by electing three Conservative councillors in Harrow Weald.

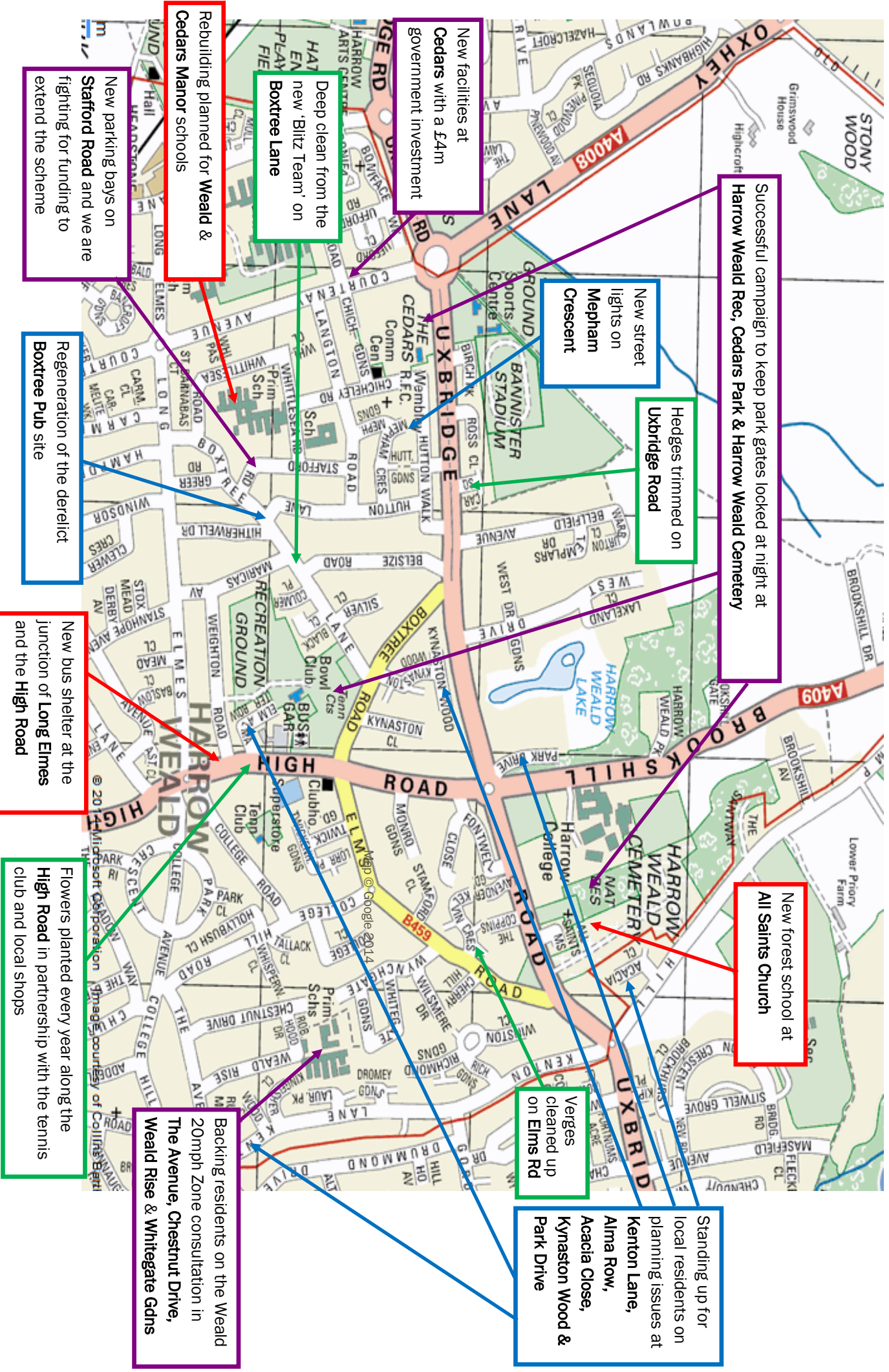
